Only the shortlisted paper presentations would be able to present on The National Homoeopathic Medical Conference.

The shortlisted UG participants should give ₹.250/- and ₹. 350/- from PG participants as the registration fees for the paper presentations on The National Homoeopathic Medical Conference.
